cooking, & Webelos I are serving), water (Kennell Lake's water is well water, ~1 gal of water per person per day is typical), weather dependent items (poncho, sunscreen), bug repellent, snacks, & a great attitude (camp chair for Saturday night Pack mtg.).

**Items to Bring if camping:** Items above, plus Chair/stool, flashlight, whistle, Fishing gear, any medications needed, any special family experiences/stories & a great attitude

Camping supplies: tent, ground tarp, sleeping items (pillow, blanket/sleeping bag, pad)

Bathroom essentials: toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, washcloth, towel, & brush

Clothes: swim suit, change of clothes, durable shoes, warm jacket/sweatshirt/pants at night

Food: snacks, Friday dinner, Saturday breakfast, lunch & side/dessert for dinner to share

Cooking/eating/cleaning gear: fork, spoon, knife, plate, cup, bowl, biodegradable soap, liquid bleach, wash tubs, scouring pads, napkins/paper towels, trash bags

Optional Items: Camera, binoculars, sunglasses, hat, paper & pencil, nature books, Dutch oven, personal first aid kit

**The following food will be provided by the pack: Saturday dinner (hotdogs, hamburgers, baked beans) & Sunday breakfast (pancakes & sausage).**

## Tentative Agenda

**Friday → 5 - 10 PM** – Arrive at site, setup tents & campsite, review ground rules (listed below), 6 PM prepare & eat dinner (on your own or as a group/den), then ending with a nice campfire with marshmallows.

**Saturday → 7:30 AM** – Prepare, eat breakfast & clean up (on your own or as a group),

**8:30 AM** – review ground rules, Scouts & families to play Ultimate Frisbee & Volleyball while scouts are working on their Ultimate Frisbee or Volleyball Beltloop, possibly a craft

**11:30 AM** – eat lunch & clean up (on your own or as a group) & free time, Fishing, swimming, Tug of War contest,
