and 1 parent/adult for Package E + Pioneer Day admissions, add \$30 for each additional scout or parent. For any additional events please refer to the Lincoln Pilgrimage forms.

Items to Bring for Saturday activities only: Lunch, water, weather dependent items (poncho, sunscreen), bug repellent, snacks, & a great attitude.

Optional Items: Camera, binoculars, paper & pencil, nature books, personal first aid kit. We recommend you carry these few items in a small backpack. Clearly mark all items with your name and pack number (73).

Items to Bring if camping: Items above, plus a tent, tarp (under tent), sleeping items (pillow, blanket/sleeping bag, etc.), clothes, food (Saturday breakfast & lunch, snacks, Sunday breakfast & lunch), & a great attitude. Also activities for the scouts to do will be supplied (for Friday, & Sunday – Saturday should be a busy day).

The following food will be provided by the pack: Friday dinner (hotdogs, s'mores).
