**Event Description:** 2010 Pathways Spring Camp at Camp Wokanda in Mossville, IL is on April 10<sup>th</sup> (camping on 4/9 – 4/11) this year. Scouts will get to experience a taste of Boy Scout Summer Camp, with activities including: activities & lots of patrol based fun. There will also be Native American dance & drum demonstrations, a possibly trading post, a tug-of-war contest, Scout museum displays & lots of other attractions. Cost for this event is \$24 (which includes 1 scout and 1 parent/adult, +\$12 for each additional scout, & +\$12 for each additional

parent/adult). If you sign up after the deadline the cost goes up to \$34 (or \$17 for each additional scout/parent).

**Items to Bring for Saturday activities only:** Lunch, water (Wokanda's water has a strong iron taste), weather dependent items (poncho, sunscreen), bug repellent, snacks, & a great attitude (camp chair for Saturday night ceremony). Saturday spaghetti dinner (from Avanti's will be provided).

Optional Items: Camera, binoculars, paper & pencil, nature books, personal first aid kit. We recommend you carry these few items in a small backpack. Clearly mark all items with your name and pack number (73).

**Items to Bring if camping:** Items above, plus a tent (a cabin is also available, but it only sleeps 12 & once it is full, tent camping is the alternative), tarp (under tent), sleeping items (pillow, blanket/sleeping bag, etc.), clothes, food (Saturday breakfast & lunch, snacks, & a great attitude. Also activities for the scouts to do will be supplied (for Friday, & Sunday. Saturday should be a busy day).

**The following food will be provided by the Pack: Friday dinner (hotdogs, s'mores) & Sunday breakfast (pancakes & sausage).**
